




Used Examples	Reading	Meaning	In Sentence	Meaning
一つ	Hitotsu ひとつ	one	すみません。それを一つください。 (Sumimasen, sore o hitotsu kudasai)	Excuse me, can I take one of it?
一人	Hitori ひとり	one person	一人でホンコンにいきます。 (Hitori de Hon-Kon ni ikimasu.)	I go to Hong Kong alone .
一日	Ichinichi いちにち	one day	ホンコンに一日います。 (Hon-Kon ni ichinichi imasu)	I am in Hong Kong for one day .
ついたち 一日	Tsuitachi ついたち	the first day of the month	一日にホンコンにいけます (Tsuitachi ni Hon-Kon ni ikimasu)	On the first day of the month I will go to Hong Kong.

二つ	Futatsu ふたつ	two	コーヒーを二つください。 (Koohee o futatsu kudasai)	Two cups of coffee, please.
二人	Futari ふたり	two people	二人でいきます。 (Futari de ikimasu.)	Two of us are going.
ふつ 二日	Futsuka ふつか	two days	パリに二日いました。 (Pari ni futsuka imashita.)	We have stayed in Paris for two days .
	Futsuka ふつか	the second day of the month	きょうは二日です。 (Kyou wa futsuka desu.)	Today is the second day of the month .
じかん 二時間	Nijikan にじかん	two hours	テニスを二時間しました。 (Tenisu o ni jikan shimashita..)	I played tennis for two hours .

* According to Wikipedia definition : **Furigana** (振り仮名) is a Japanese reading aid, consisting of smaller kana, or syllabic characters, printed next to a kanji (ideographic character) or other character to indicate its pronunciation. It is one type of ruby text. **Furigana** is also known as yomigana (読み仮名) or rubi (ルビ) in Japanese.
