


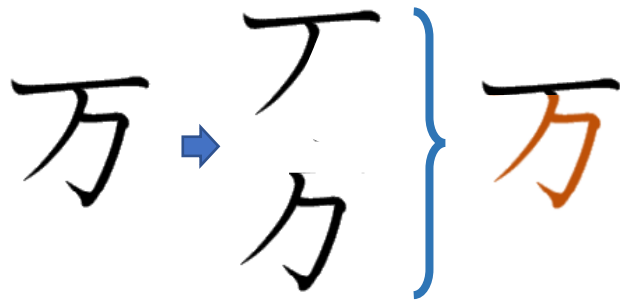

When we look at the figure we can see a “T” and “h” combined. T may represent “Ten” and h may represent the second letter of “Thousand”.
Altogether it makes ten thousand.
