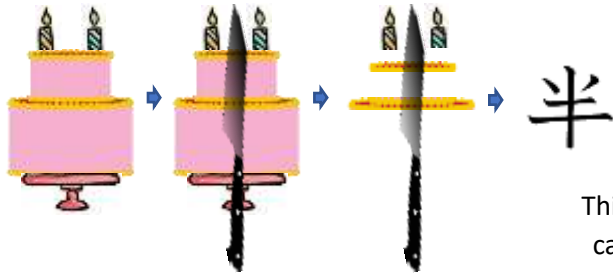

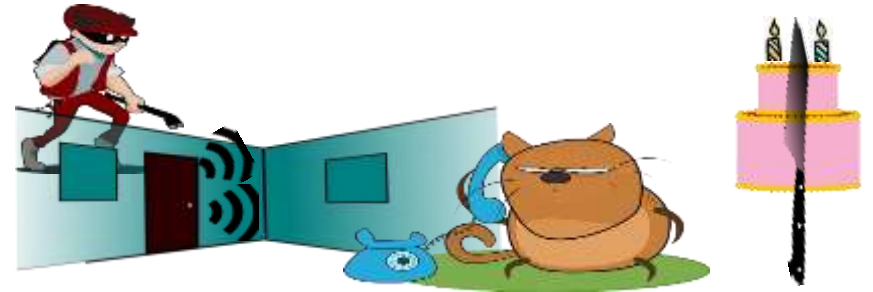
FIGURE REMINDER



Think that you divide the birthday cake in the middle (with a knife) to two **halves**.

(Half → Cake divided to two halves)

READING REMINDER
