




READING REMINDER



These 10 people go to church early in the morning. **Morning** is the time when sun begins to shine fast and the moon disappears.
(Morning → Sun shines and the moon disappears as fast as daybreak occurs.)



Asahi Bier is very famous in Japan. Good **cho**ice to drink.
Asahi means the morning sun.
(To remember its readings **ASA** and **CHOU**.)



(Noon/Daytime → Crouched man watching the sun at noon.)
